This Directorate, in November, 2016 has lifted the ban on grant of approvals to new and existing maritime training institutes for conduct of GP rating course.

- 2. Initially these institutes are granted approval for an intake of 40 candidates per batch with a frequency of 2 batches in a year. It is observed that the institutes approach this Directorate for additional intake before the completion of the 1st batch and also before placing their students on board.
- 3. In view of the above, it is hereby clarified that those new institutes who have been granted approval for an intake of 40 candidates per batch should approach this Directorate for an additional intake, (if need be), only after on board placement of the initial 40 students for whom they have been approved for. No additional intake of GP rating candidates will be entertained by this Directorate before the onboard placement of the 1st batch students.

Once the Directorate is satisfied of the placement, only then their application for additional intake will be considered, if they are otherwise eligible in accordance with the guidelines and circulars issued by this office from time to time.
