Guidelines for carrying out Comprehensive Inspection Programme (CIP) by maritime training institutes was issued vide DGS Order No.4 of 2016 dated 12.09.2016. Further amendment to the DGS order was made vide Training Circular No.1 of 2017 dated 13.1.2017.

2. Some maritime training institutes have requested for additional/enhancement of seats on the basis of para 2 of Training Circular No.1 of 2017 dated 13.01.2017, if they achieve the grade of B1 (Good) or above.

3. Hence, it is clarified that the existing institutes become eligible to apply for new pre-sea courses or enhancement of seats after achieving A1, A2, B1 CIP grading but only for the courses where no ban has been imposed. For the courses which are still under ban, the above clause will not be applicable. Similarly, the Institutes will have to fulfil the other eligibility criteria before making an application for a new course or enhancement of seats.



4. Only institutes who are eligible for reward of 25% additional intake as per para 13 of DGS Order No.4 of 2016 shall be eligible to apply even if there is general ban on new course or enhancement of seats. The applicant will have, to however, fulfil the condition laid down in para 13 of DGS Order 4 of 2016 dated 12.9.2016 and other requirements laid out in DGS circulars and orders.

5. All other conditions remain unchanged.
