Procedures for Pilot Remote Competency Examination

- 1. Whereas vide DGS Order 33 of 2021dated 26.10.2021, the Directorate conveyed its intent to stakeholders and readiness to start Remote Competence Examination and has decided to conduct a pilot examination serving both the purpose of trials as well as award of results towards the competence examinations.
- 2. Whereas the said DGS Order specified that, the dates for practice and pilot examinations shall be declared.
- 3. The purpose of this Order is to provide detailed procedures for:
 - 3.1 Registration on e-examination system.
 - 3.2 Booking for Remote Pilot Examinations.
 - 3.3 Booking for pilot examination:pilot Exams will be conducted for the paper "Terrestrial & Coastal Navigation" for 2nd Mates Nautical and "Marine Engineering Practice" for MEO Class IV Engineering.
 - 3.4 Procedure for booking of seats will be as per existing DGS procedures. Candidates opting for remote digital written examination by proctoring need to immediately book their seats by clicking on "www.e-examinations.in"

- 5. Video links demonstrating the registration for digital exam, booking for digital, etc. will be available on the website www.e-examinations.in. If facing any issues, candidates may request for support by sending email to "support@e-examinations.in".
- 6. The schedule of practice examinations shall be forwarded to candidate on his e-mail id registered on his seafarer profile after he completes e-examination registration process.
- 7. Those candidates who wish to appear for digital examination and have completed seat booking procedure and have paid the fees as per existing DGS Procedures should go to "www.e-examinations.in" and register on the digital examination portal. Once the admit card gets issued, these candidates will be able to convert their booking into a digital booking on "www.e-examinations.in"
- 8. The candidates who opt for digital examination mode will be provided with detailed familiarization and practice sessions before the pilot exam.
